- Encourage your student to reach out to their teacher if they have any questions or concerns or need any extra help.




3. Gmail - Email

Each student has a Gmail account and uses it daily in school

- Note that “Hangouts” is a Gmail feature that allows users to quickly chat back and forth.

4. Meet - Video conferencing

- meet.google.com
- All virtual classes are pre-scheduled at the same time everyday.
- Students simply click on the class name to join everyday.
- Students MUST attend their virtual classes every single day. (Class schedule is attached.)
- Students MUST have their camera turned on and be appropriately dressed.
- Missing students will be marked as absent if they do not attend and will need an excuse.
- Any student having technical difficulties will be responsible for emailing their teacher to explain.
